### COURSE OF ITALIAN LANGUAGE

The **Standard Course of Italian Language and Culture** is an intensive course of 20 hours every week which runs from Monday to Friday from 9 to 13 for a total of 160 hours for two months.

To study the Italian language a more personalized you can add to the standard course of individual lessons. This course allows the student to acquire the four skills (listening, reading, writing and speaking) and the development of a "fifth skill" by which the student learns to understand even the language and nonverbal communication codes Italy through topics related to various aspects of Italian culture, lifestyle and way of being Italian.

To achieve this objective, the course includes the participation of a teacher with specific learning tasks and use the following tools:

#### TEACHING TOOLS

- Lectures
- Discussion led
- Individual and group exercises
- Authentic audio and video materials
- Newspaper articles
- Games
- Dealing with issues of complexity gradually

The teaching method is based on motivation to learn through direct communication between the teacher and the student, taking into account age, cultural background and objectives of the student.

The course aims to gradually achieve the language skills of comprehension, expression, reading and writing, and in-depth historical and artistic aspects through visits to places of the city with the student and the tutor.

The language is taught using traditional teaching materials and authentic teaching materials, and through activities such as games, discussions and educational tools such as songs and video.

Depending on the level of the course topics are treated with simple or complex reading texts and newspapers and you will begin to explore issues of design in such a way as to facilitate the access of the student culture and Italian society and facilitates its participation in the life daily and the integration of course design.
